## Deposit

A non-refundable, non-transferrable deposit of \$1000 is to be charged to the credit card provided to secure the hold on the restaurant. The deposit is included as part of the overall minimum spend.

We will continue to take reservations until we receive a signed copy of the contract, a credit card and the deposit.

## Minimum Spend

Our minimum spend is based on guest consumption.

If a client surpasses the minimum spend, they will be charged based on their overall consumption.

If a client does not meet their minimum spend, they will be charged a rental fee to reach the agreed upon balance with applicable taxes and gratuity applied.

*A client may not make up their minimum spend amount through off-sales.*



## Beverage

Feature cocktails from our list can be made available upon request prior to the event.

Guests will have the opportunity to customize alcohol service (welcome cocktail/bubbles, wines for dinner, etc) once the event has been booked.

Wine can be chosen from our menu.



## Canapés

A selection of canapés are available to pre order for your event. Canapes are charged at \$4 per unit and a minimum order is 1 per guest for each selection.

## Taxes & Gratuity

All applicable taxes in BC and a 20% gratuity charge applies to all food and beverage (including deposit).

In the event that a guest doesn't hit the minimum spend, taxes and gratuity will be applied to the agreed upon minimum spend amount.

## Cancellation Policy

If a cancellation happens with less than 7 days' notice there will be a charge of \$2,500.00 to the credit card provided.
